QUICK GUIDE: WHAT TO EXPECT

ON WHICH LEVEL?

Simply let your gaze wander over Stuttgart, the station and the construction site. The rooftop terrace offers more than just a good view of the construction work on the through station.

The future station comes alive for you over its full length of 420 metres. A glimpse on the tablet is all it takes for you to experience the future

in real time.

Meeting in a unique location: Almost 30 metres above excavation level, you have the possibility to advance your projects in the modern conference room.

Actively through the station and the region.
What benefits will the rail project have for the S-Bahn? What does digital rail for Germany mean and why is Stuttgart a pilot hub? Steer your way through the future station and its surrounding area already today. You can use a joystick to move around the space-filling projection "The Cave" in real size and explore the future station.

The future station comes to life using augmented reality (AR). Experience how trains arrive and how you will be able to move around in the new station in the future. What does the new Stuttgart Rosenstein look like and why is the one connected to the other?

On this level, you will be introduced to the Stuttgart-Ulm Rail Project. News from the media and from the construction site – a quick point of entry to the project.
